In the fall of that year, Kelly moved to Wilmington, North Carolina and spent 2 seasons dancing with U.S. International Ballet, directed by Walter Angelini and Ines Albertini. In these two years, she has taught and choreographed for studios in the Wilmington area and attained hands-on professional experience in a ballet company.
